What's going on? We will be comparing and contrasting texts and reviewing personal pronouns (I, she, etc.) in reading. Students will have the same timed multiplication fact quiz this week, so 0, 1, 2, 5, 9, and 10 facts will be on this week's quiz. It is very important that you only practice the facts we are working on in class. We will continue reviewing measurement with time in math. You can help your child by having them tell the time throughout the day, write a start and finish time for doing chores to find the elapsed time, tell you how many more minutes until ___ o'clock, etc. We will continue learning about plant functions and animal biomes during our science unit on Environmental Science.

In your child's folder there is a letter explaining a math program we have been using at school. Your child's Moby Max login and password are on the letter. Incorporate this website into your child's computer time as much as possible.
