What's going on? welcome back to school! we are ready for a great school year! our classroom and school policies and procedures will be practiced every day along with routines in each subject area. we will be taking assessments in each subject to see what your child has and has not mastered as of the beginning of third grade. A copy of these results will be sent home. This week in Reading we will begin working with the wordly wise vocabulary program. we will also practice reading fluency procedures and how to track progress. Students will also discover what kind of "smart" they are as we learn about the multiple intelligences. Students may bring a ball to play with at recess as long as they are safe. A monthly Reading Log and Physical Activity Log will go home with your child this week. It will be due on the first school day of the following month. These two logs will remain in the back pocket of your child's green folder. Third grade is one of the most important grades during your child's academic career. It is crucial to your child's success this year that you help maintain consistency of school and classroom expectations at home.

Things to Know

Conduct: Your child will receive a conduct grade everyday on this newsletter. It will remain in the front of their green folder and must be returned SIGNED to school every day.

weekly Newsletter: Each week you will receive this newsletter to inform you of things going on in school and class, upcoming dates, reminders, and any information that will keep you better informed.

Homework: Homework starts this week. Your child will receive a Reading/ELA homework packet and a math/Sci/SS packet every Monday, and it will be due the Friday of that week. This gives your child the whole week to finish it instead of one night! ☺ Everything that is in the homework packet will be things your child has done in class, or it will be review work. It is worth 20 points.

Math Textbook: Your child will receive a math textbook that will stay at home all year. This will be used for homework. It is checked out under your child's name, so it is your child's responsibility to take care of it.

Positive Behavior Parties: At the end of each month all third grade students who have excellent conduct will be able to attend our positive behavior party. If a student earns more than two C letter grades, they will not be allowed to participate in the party. Conduct grades of a D or F are not acceptable. Encourage your child to be respectful, responsible, and safe.

Forms and Fees: over the next week or two you will be receiving MANY important papers. Complete and return these as soon as possible. The school supply fee may be sent in cash or a check written to The Dufrocq School.

Uniform Policy: Students must wear a belt with bottoms that have belt loops. Their shirt must be tucked in at all times. Students are not allowed to have fake nails or large jewelry.
